Which Survey is stated to have been commenced the 20th June 1793. and by him returned to the Surveyor General's Office in dispute with other interfering Surveys, as represented by that original diagram hereto annexed from the disputed files. And now in pursuance of a decision of the Supreme Court in favor of the holders of these Warrants above named and inserted, and that Patents might issue upon them, a Copy of which (decision) from 3 Watts & Sergeant - page 465. 899. is also hereto annexed. I have now caused this division of the land to be made and set off in the general draft to the said several respective Warrants in the Surveyor General's Office. so that Patents may issue upon them accordingly.
