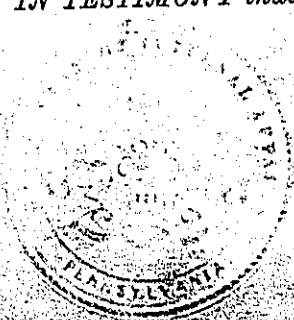


The above Irregular Draught Describes a Tract of Land in Possession of John Walker amongst the Barren Hills & includes a Tract of about 167^a which was by my Father Survey'd for Jno Barclay the 17th of the 2nd mo 1737 By Warrant of the 13th of the month called May 1736 m^o he the said Barclay afterwards sold to Nicholald White who obtained two additional warrants thereto the first bearing Date the 1st day of February 1748 & the other the 8th of August 1749 & he sold his Right of the whole to the aforesaid John Walker for whom this Survey was made the 4th of the 3rd mo 1754 Beginning for the whole Tract at a White oak on the South West side of Octorara Creek standing just below the Forks thereof & near the end of the Pine Hill & running thence according to the several Courses Distances & Boundaries above set forth By
