 which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warant Granted to Matthew Brown Dated 15<sup>th</sup> February 1743 and  
 Twenty Five acres and 156 perches & allowance was Surveyed 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1752 in pursuance of a Small  
 Warant Granted to Matthew Brown dated 3<sup>rd</sup> Feby 1749 Surveyed the above described piece of  
 Land for Samuel Pusey November 16<sup>th</sup> 1836
