



Situate in Hopewell Township, in the County of York, Containing within the above given lines 245 A 129 P & allowance. The part where the letter A stands, Contains 51 Acres and allowance and was originally surveyed on the 1st of the 1st Mo 1773 for John Richey in pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{as} dated the (31st) day of Oct 1770. The part B B contain 28 1/4^{as} and allowance and appear to be parts of a larger tract of 139 7/8^{as} Originally Surveyed for Jas^{ts} M^c Gauleffs in pursuance of a warrant dated the 15th day of Nov. 1787. The part where the letter C stands, now containing 134^{as} & 20^{ps} & allowance is part of a larger tract, originally surveyed by William Matthews late D. S. on the 17th day of the 12th Mo. 1773 for John Richey in pursuance of a warrant, dated the 24th day of Nov 1773. D, containing 62^{as} 69^{ps} and allowance is part of a larger tract of 69^{as} and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant for 60 acres granted to David Gorsuch, dated the 10th day of Nov 1793. Executed by William Kenney late D. S. on the 8th day of the 11th mo. 1794. The above was plotted and calculated in One Draft, at the request of John Leib and Frederick Smith, who are desirous to get the above land Patented on the 24th day of Feb^y 1849.
