



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Godorus Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 10^{ac} 29 perches & allowance &c part of 134^{ac} 9 & 8 q perches & allowance &c which was originally surveyed on the 22^d day of October 1752 by George Stevens late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} granted to Daniel Heckintorn bearing date the 18th day of December 1751. And recently survey by Peter Spangler late D.S. on the 23^d day of January 1821. by the old Settled^{lines} of the Present adjourns, and excluding all the interfering claims, in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to Philip Gertzler bearing date the 8th day of January 1821. Now on the 4th day of December A.D. 1837 Resurveyed & Calculated the above &c at the request of John Zorback the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation
