



A Return of this Tract was made last summer, & at a hearing <sup>then</sup> in the Land Office upon the caveat of Hieronymus Eckman (who lay claim to 25<sup>th</sup> thereof at 7) it was ordered that a Barren Hill at the East side should be added to make the Survey more Regular & that the whole be returned to Geo. W. Gullough on <sup>ch</sup> is accordingly done this 22<sup>nd</sup> of July 10<sup>th</sup> mo 1766

Geo. Churchman to whom the said order was sent.
