



The above Diagram represents a tract of Land in Tyrone township, containing in the whole 280^{ac} 69^{ps} and allowance (exclusive of the Church ground above marked, which contains about 53 perches and allowance). Originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for 200^{ac} dated the 11th of June A.D. 1762 granted to Henry Gass (as per official Draught appears) And now resurveyed the above part of 99 acres 113 perches and allowance for John Dunkelberger the present owner and occupier the 11th June A.D. 1822
