



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of November 1772 requiring me to Resurvey for Gadwalader Evans a lot of ground appurtenant to the Original Purchase of 500<sup>ac</sup> made of the State by William Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> Dec<sup>d</sup> by John Stringfellow - These may Certify that I did in pursuance of the said Warrant on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774 Resurvey the said Lot of Ground between the streets of the City of Philadelphia and find it to be situate on the South side of Vine Street and between 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Streets from Delaware River containing in Breadth East and West Ninety Nine feet and in Length North and South Three Hundred and Six feet bounded Northward by Vine Street aforsaid Westward with Sixth Street and Southward and Eastward with Vacant Ground
