



A draught of A Tract of Land Situate on the heads of the Dry Run Commonly known by the name of the glade run in Muncy Hills, in Turbutt Township and County of Northumberland, Survey'd the 29th of November 1774 by Charles Lukens the then Deputy Surveyor of the District, and Resurvey'd by me on the Eighth day of March 1787 for Morgan Connor by Virtue of his Warrant, bearing date the 21st day of October 1774 Containing three hundred & fifteen acres & - half with the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ cent.
