



Situate on the west side of Youghiogeni River in Henry Clay township Fayette county (1 1/2 miles below Smithfield) and Surveyed the 29th day of June 1835 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Jacob Bell for 400^{ac} dated the 10th day of February 1794.
 There is about 70 acres cleared, two dwelling houses, a sawmill. The improvement is about 20 years old & now occupied by Jonas Critchfield
