



Situate in Franklin Township York County containing as above set forth thirty three acres one hundred and forty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c<sup>d</sup> Being part of a larger tract of 215<sup>ac</sup> 58<sup>per</sup> & allowance. Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1821 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Brackin for 200<sup>ac</sup> dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1775 The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract at the request of John Schultz the present owner of said part who desires the same to be returned for confirmation

November 10<sup>th</sup> 1821.
