



A Draught of a tract of Land, Situate in Upper Merion Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing one Hundred and Eighty Two Acres and Sixty Two Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly surveyed for Jacob Smider in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 22<sup>d</sup> August Anno 1758 - who sold his Right to the same to other Persons, who again to Jacob Ringel, and he again to David Smith, and he again to George Bishung, to whom it was resurveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> February, Anno 1767 - By order of the Surveyor General.
