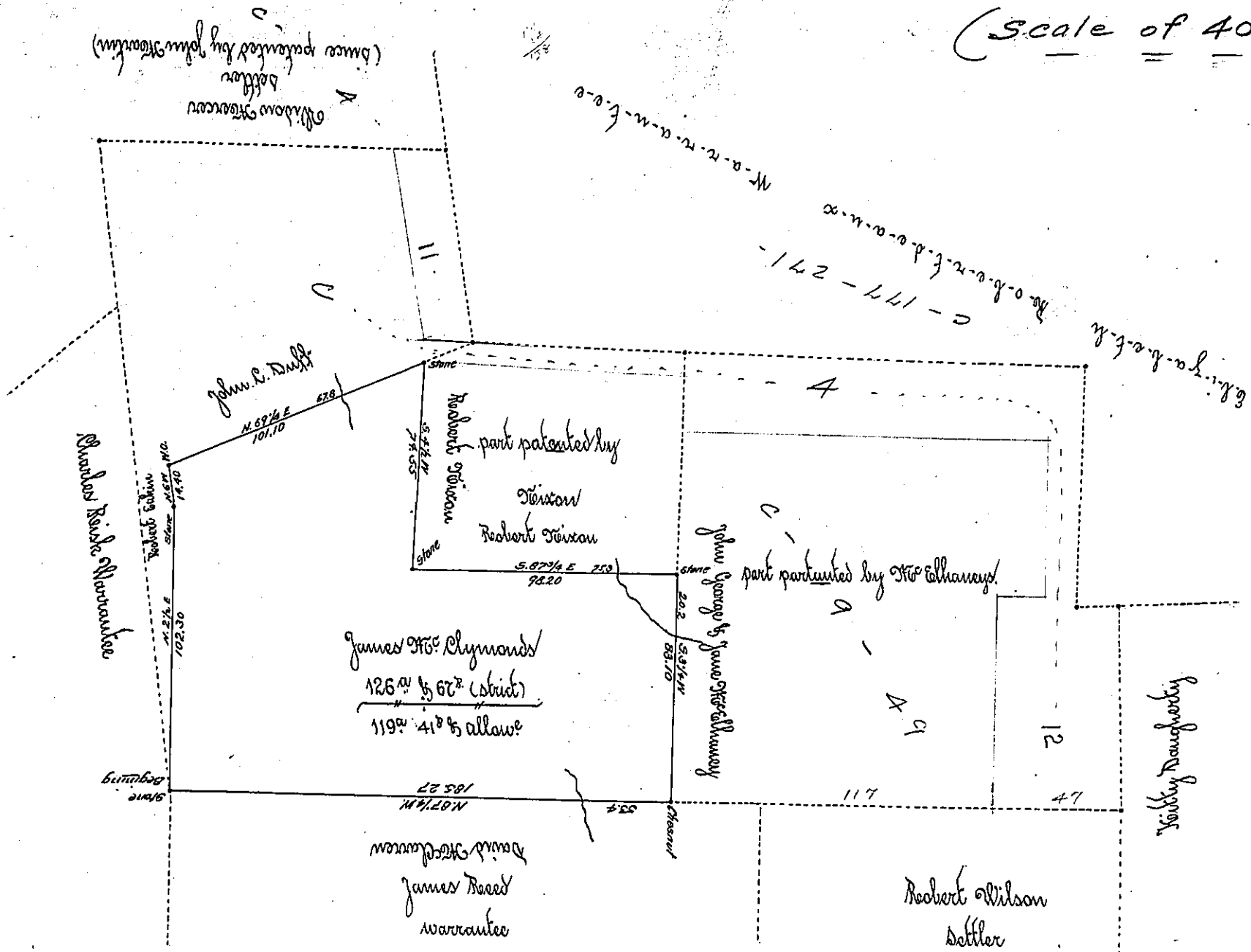

The above is a draft of a tract of land situated in the township of Doubtless, and County of Beaver containing one hundred and twenty six acres and sixty seven perches strict measure. Surveyed on Application of James Mc Clymonds the 25th day of November 1875: it being part of a larger tract of 405 Acres & 45 perches & allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Alexander dated 20th day of February 1815. (Outer Lines show this James Alexander Warrant (see A. 3. 159) to William McCandless, Secretary of Internal Affairs.
