



The above described tract of land, situate in Traddysville Township Chester County containing fifty six Acres and seventy eight Perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, was surveyed and returned by Charles Dilworth in three separate tracts, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Francis Allison dated 23rd February 1765 -

The warrant was for 50 Acres, and 56th 28th being returned thereon no more was legally accepted - The Draft of the whole appears to have been returned by the Deputy Surveyor -
