



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Sept: 7<sup>th</sup> 1825. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Cox for twenty Acres of land unimproved Dated August 19<sup>th</sup> 1825. but Contains twenty three Acres, and 118 perches, and Allowance of six per Cent for highways, situate on the waters of Ten mile Creek in East Bethlehem Township, W. County, From the best information I could obtain at the time of Survey nearly two thirds of the above land has been well improved for twenty five years
