Bounded on the surrounding shores by lands of Hiram Denison and lands of Stark and Courtwright, the above mentioned Island was surveyed to low water mark and contains seventeen acres and thirty one perches (17<sup>ac</sup> 31<sup>per</sup> 1/2) strict measure

Surveyed the above Island to David Culver and William Culver in pursuance of their warrant dated October 4<sup>th</sup> A.D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870)
