Surveyed on Warrant dated 5th Oct. 1867 - and the dotted lines represent the Survey as I heretofore returned it on the Warrant in the name of Lingenfelter, I claim that I am joint owner with Jacob Lingenfelter of that Warrant, and of the land Surveyed thereon and I protest against the Order of Resurvey, and against this Return which I have made because Lingenfelter insists in it. I refer to my affidavit heretofore sent to the Board of Property for the true State of facts in this Case I also desire to say that the order of Resurvey in this case was not placed in my hands until the 29th day of Jan'y. 1870
