



Situate on the Waters of the North fork of Buffalo^{lick} Creek in Brothers Valley Township (formerly Bedford) Now Somerset County & originally Surveyed by Thomas Vickroy then Assistant to Alexander McClean Esqr. deputy surveyor, on which there has been a Patent Granted bearing date the 18th day of March 1803 And Whereas SA. Patent is found to be Erronius when running some division lines thro' the same, at the Instance and request of the owner resurveyed said tract of Land the first day of November 1803 and find the same when accurately measured to Contain as above represented - the owner therefore prays that another Patent may Issue for the same agreeable to the above Platt instead of the former return, in pursuance of his said warrant dated the 28th day of July 1785, for 400a.
