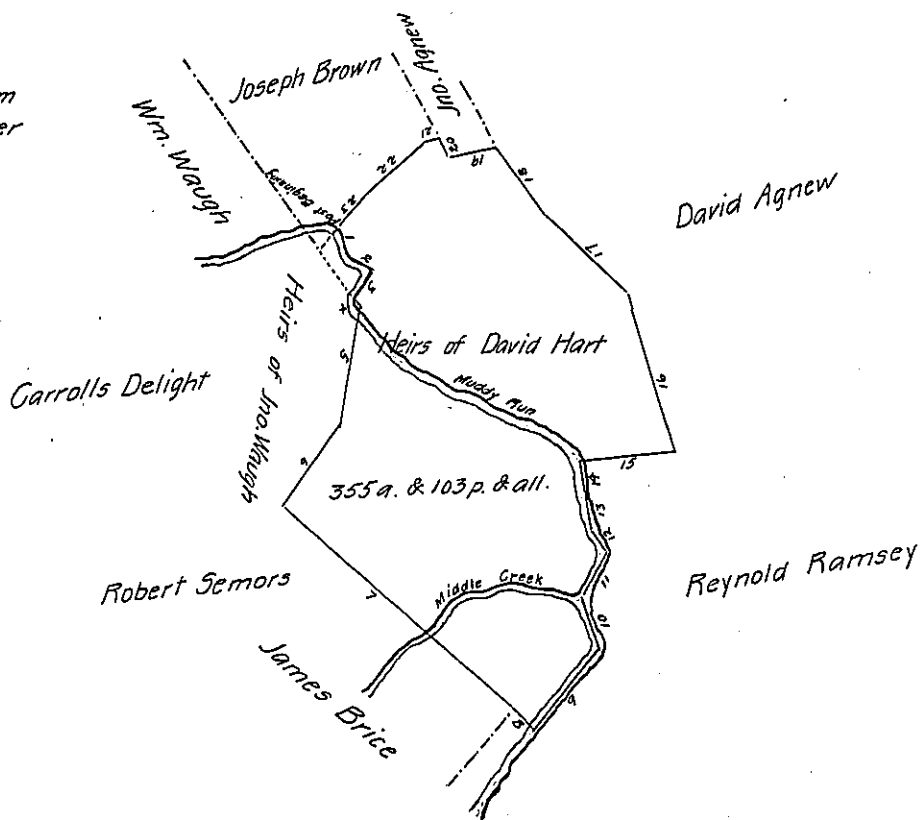


Courses Beginning at post in the Road leading from Nichols Gap to York in Joseph Browns Line & is a Corner of Land of the Heirs of John Waugh.
