Cent for Roads &c. - 84 acres 24 perches & allowance, being part of 157 as. 29 p. & allowance - which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant, granted to William Leman, Junr. for 150 as. Dated the 17th Day of June 1767 - and 23 as. & allowance, being part of 155 as. 41 p. and allce. - which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the said William Leman, Junr. for 100 acres - Dated the 13th. of January 1759.

Surveyed the above described piece of Land, for Christian Brackbill, the 13th. Day of August 1822.
