

By Virtue of a warrt. from the Hon Proprietaries bearing Date January 6th. 17738 | Ihave Survey'd and Laid out unto James Brown on Yellow Beeches Creck in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna River—One Hundred and twenty acres of Land with allowance of Six p Cent. Beginning at a Wallow Tree by the Said Creck north Eight Degrees Westerly thence by the Land of John Rankin. One hundred and twenty three pches to a Black Oak thence South Eighty two Degrees Westerly One Hundred Sixty five perches to a White Oak by the said Creck then Down the Same Traversing the Severall Courses thereof Near about 245 perches to The Beginning
