



The Draft of a tract of Land Situate in Newton Township Cumberland County containing two hundred & nine acres & 109 perches & allowance &c. It being part of a Larger tract Surveyed on a warrant granted to James Kilgore Dated the 15th of April 1752. The original of the above has been delivered over to me by my predecessor Dan^l Henderson Esquire as an official paper the survey was made under the Direction of Mathew or Daniel Henderson at the time the whole survey was made from what appears by the papers & struck off for Jesse Kilgore.
