 A warrant was granted to John Phelps, dated Feb'y 29, 1788, covering the part of this tract shown by dotted lines above, in pursuance of which a survey was made March 15, 1788. But this warrant and survey do not interfere with the remaining portion surveyed for Samuel Holt's heirs; the original warrant to William Hill having extended to the river and included both the Phelps and Holt tracts.
