Which was Originally Surveyed by Lewis Lewis late D.S. under Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 18th day of March A. D. 1771, In pursuance of the Application N^o 2100 for 100^{ac} Granted to John Calhoon bearing date the 5th day of December 1766, Resurveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. in the month of May 1799, And on the 6th & 7th days of May 1800, Divided off from the said larger tract of land. And now at the request of the owner Jacob Cockley the same is returned for Confirmation the 30th day of December 1814, —
