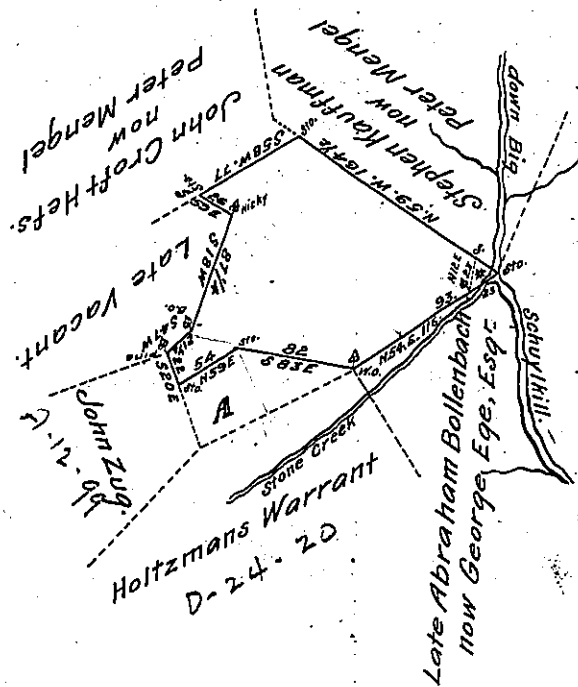

 Agent for the Assignee of Geo. Ege. Esq. The whole Survey, including the Small tract in the dotted line A.
 Present owner now 1838, was afterwards covered again by a Survey made under a War-
 rant granted to John Zug. dated the 10. of October. A.D. 1787. -
