



Situate in Washington township York County containing as above set forth twenty-two acres and one hundred and fifty-one perches and the usual allowance of six per cent & c. Being part of a larger tract of 470^{ac} & 99^{ps} and allowance of land originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 17th day of the 10th Month 1765 for John Thomas in pursuance of two warrants one granted to Daneil James for 10^{ac} dated Feby. 26, 1745, and the other granted to James Lenox for 100^{ac} more or less dated the 6th day of May 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 20th day of September 1867, at the request of Joanna Mc. Elwee who desired the part included within the lines shaded with yellow, to be returned & c.
