# Old Improvement; foundation of chimney and logs decayed, made prior to 1814 -Note, on above date 16th June 1830 Mrs. Dorcus Stackpole appeared in person, and discharged me from making a Survey, so as to include any part of her claim, at same time, entered her Caveate in Legal form, against a Patent issuing for the same to Samuel Holliday 4: -

It appears at the time above addition was made by M. M. Monahan, the part, without the Survey of Samuel Holliday, as first made, (as above laid down) belonged to Dorcus Sta-kpole, and other heirs of James Stackpole, Deceas!; now owned by Sam! Holliday, by purchase from said
