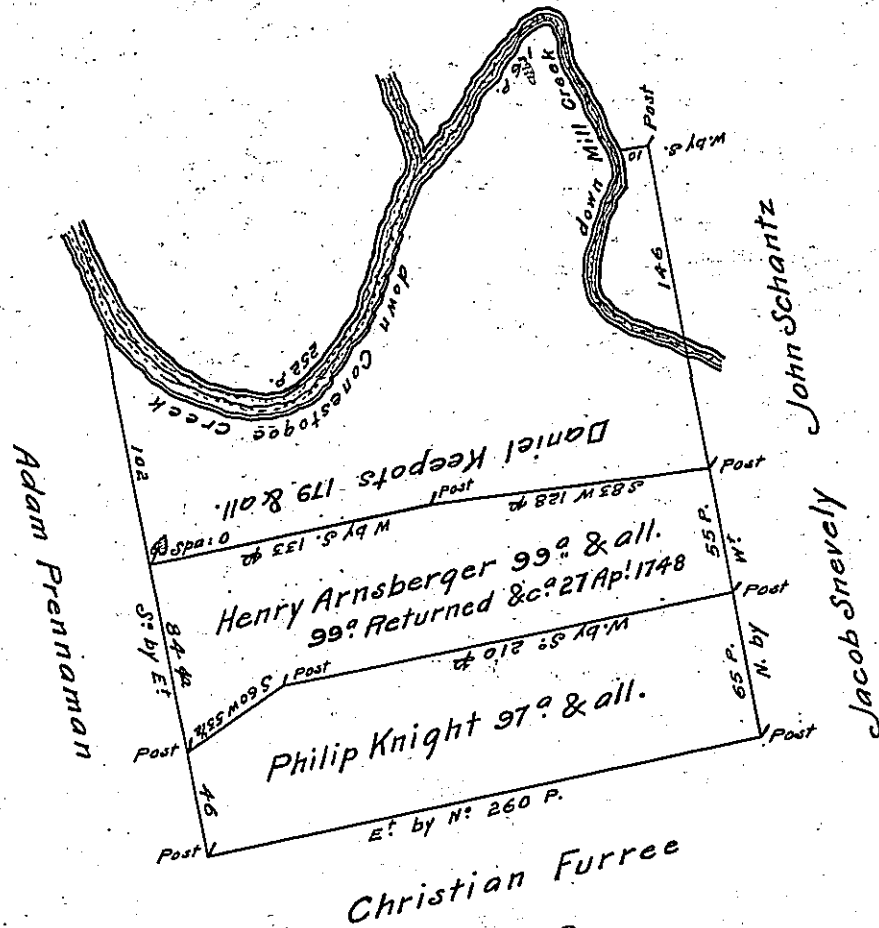

The said Christopher Franciscus sold 200^o of the above to Hans Neisley who sold 100^o to Philip Knight & 100^o to Henry Arnsperger.

And he Sold the other 200^o to Hans Graff. who transferred to Geo: Cryder who married a Daughter of Hans Graffe, & George Cryder being Dead & the Widow married to Dan! Keepots on a Settlem^t of the Estate before the Orphans Court it was allowed to Dan! Keepots as his Wifes Share to take a Patent for the above place which is the State of the Case of that Tract as the Secretary desired to be informed.
