Who sold 100: to Finish Tinght Crown to the Sold the other 200? to Hans Graff. who transferred to Geo: Cryder who married a Daughter of Hans Graffe, & George Crydor being Dead & the Widow married to Dan! Keepots on a Settem! of the Estate before the Orphans Court it was allowed to Dan! Keepots as his Wifes Share to take a Patent for the above place which is the State of the Case of that Tract as the Secretary desired to be informed.
