



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 18th Day of April 1744 to resurvey to Hairy Lisle a Bank and Water Lot of Ground between Spruce Street and Dock Street adjoining a Lot of Abraham Vining and to extend the same Eastward into the River so far as Samuel Powell's Ground is extended I have resurveyed unto the said Hairy Lisle the said Lot of Ground which being extended as aforesaid is bounded and limited according to this Draught Resurveyed the 18th Day of April 1744
