



A Draught of a Piece of land, situate in Manchester Township, in the County of York, Pennsylvania, containing as above set forth 50^{ac} and the usual allowances &c. which is part of 439^{ac} 92^{pr} & allowances, &c. which has been surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 19th December, 1775, and since by Jacob Spangler late D.S. on the 28th May, 1805, in pursuance of 2 warrants, granted to Baltzer Kretzer, dated respectively the 8th day of May 1742, and returned by Jacob Spangler, then D.S. And now the above having been resurveyed on the 26th day of October, 1849. And now at the request of the present Owner Henry Ensminger, wishes the above to be returned into the Surveyor General's Office, who wishes to patent the same.
