



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York containing as above set forth forty-one acres and thirteen perches and allowance, being part of a larger tract of 383 1/2 & 158 perches & allowance, which was originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1762, in pursuance of a warrant to agree for 200<sup>acres</sup> granted to Christian Landus bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January 1762. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1802, at the request of the owner who desires the same to be returned for Confirmation.
