


Plat of land described in Warrant, dated

To the Hon. The Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania

This is to Certify that on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February <sup>1868</sup> I surveyed a certain Island in French Creek, in the Township of Le Beauff, opposite the lands of William McClenahan on the East side and George Sherwin on the West side of said Creek on the application of Thomas McClenahan. Said Island being bounded and described as follows to wit. Beginning at the Southern extremity of said Island at a Stake thence
