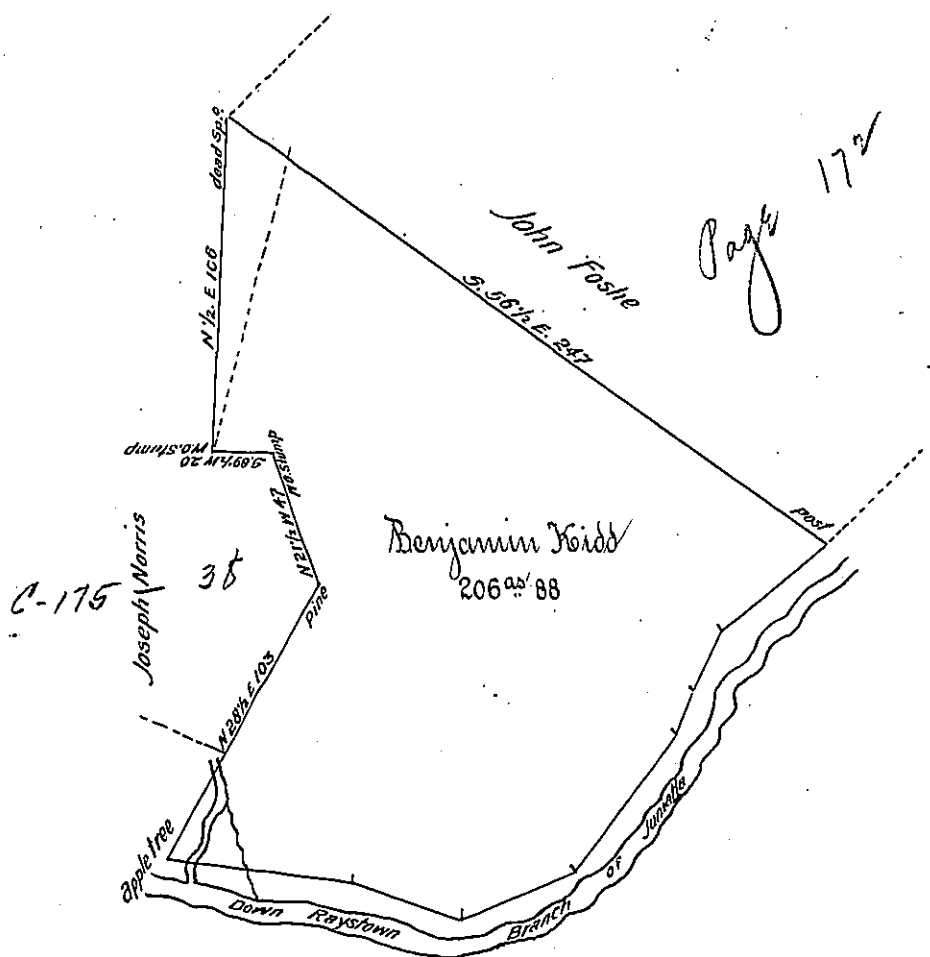

Situate on the west side of the Roystown Branch of Juniata in Hopewell township Huntingdon County containing Two Hundred and six acres and eighty eight perches and Allowance - Surveyed the 28th day of April 1850 in order to Benjamin Kidd 206 1/2 ac 88 dated the 12th day of September 1766
