



Situate in Chancery Township York County Surveyed the 5th of the 3^d anno 1773 for William Doherty in right of Charles Sharro in pursuance
of a Warrant for 100⁰ Dated the 13th of September 1750 &c. B. this Land had been run round with the rest of Chat. Sharro's Land and Chat. Doherty's Land
allow off this end to James Dickson but never got it laid off together with a Warrant right for 100⁰ and Dickson sold to Doherty & others & now at the
request of the parties its laid off for Doherty
