



Tract in Germany Township Adams County Pa. surveyed August 8<sup>th</sup> 1811 in pursuance of a warrant to George King for 121<sup>ac</sup> dated January 2<sup>nd</sup> 1811 containing one hundred & twenty five acres one hundred & twenty three perches & all. B. Being part of a tract surveyed June 12<sup>th</sup> 1766 by Archibald McLean D.S. by warrant to Abraham King dated May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1765 said to contain 157<sup>ac</sup> 37<sup>pc</sup> & all but now found to contain 159<sup>ac</sup> 17<sup>pc</sup> & all surveyed & divided from the residue August 8<sup>th</sup> 1811 for George King containing twelve acres one hundred & twenty five perches & all
