B is the same tract or piece of Land which was resurveyed on the 25th day of November 1812 for the Heirs of Christian Keener in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 2th day of October 1770 and contains fourteen acres and seventy nine perches & allowance Resurveyed September 20th 1864
