Surveyed & divided from the residue the 7<sup>th</sup> July 1809

N.B. Samuel Ewing the father of Robert Ewing the present owner of this tract obtained a warrant for 300<sup>a</sup> Dated September 10<sup>th</sup> 1787 which by its location and a rough Draught in my office appears to have been taken for 319<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres part of which to wit 68<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Acres was surveyed to Sam<sup>l</sup> Ewing December 28<sup>th</sup> 1769 by order of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 5293 Dated December 12<sup>th</sup> 1768 28<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres ~~was~~ part of 56<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & all. Surveyed June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1768 by order of survey N<sup>o</sup> 4838 Dated March 11<sup>th</sup> 1768 to John & Andrew Thomson and 222<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> acres part of 322<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of which the above Draught is a part, - the whole of the above being contained within the part intended to be covered by said warrant
