



The above draught represents a tract of Land situate in Bart township Lancaster County Containing Sixty four acres and One hundred and fifty six perches with the usual allowance of six per Cent for roads &c being part of Three hundred and thirty nine acres and ninety One perches and the usual allowance which was surveyed to Frederick Fenstermaker by warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1790, Surveyed the above 64 acres & 156 perches for Dorothy Lyle formerly Dorothy Fenstermaker of Bart township March the 10<sup>th</sup> 1853.
