



A draft of a tract of land situated in Shideley and Cromwell townships Huntingdon County (formerly Cumberland), containing seventy one acres forty-eight perches and allowance of six pr. cent. It being part of a tract of land that was surveyed on an application No 2976 dated the 3rd day of March 1767 in the name of John Holliday. Resurveyed and divided off from the residue of said tract the 22nd day of April, A.D. 1864, at the request of Robert Giffin.
