



Survey'd the above described tract of Land for Philip Grove in pursuance of his Warrant granted the 15th day of January 1814 - on the 24th May 1814 - Containing four hundred and thirty nine acres twenty five perches & nine tenths with allowance of Six Pr. Ct. &c. Situated in the Last Purchase Lycoming Township & County.

The Improvements are a house in which Grove & family reside a barn stabling & Orchard & about One hundred Acres of land Cleared -

Note The part south of the dotted line was returned to Henry Beck in pursuance of his Warrant No. though I believe the survey was subsequent to Groves Improvement & that the owner will not contend.
