Being part of a larger tract of 273^{ac} 131^{ps} & allowance, Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens Esq late D.S. on the 26th day of August A.D. 1765, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Oldshew, dated the 26th day of May A.D. 1763 - The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, on the 31st day of March 1814 - and now at the request of Philip Lehmer the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined, corrected, calculated, and returned for confirmation -
