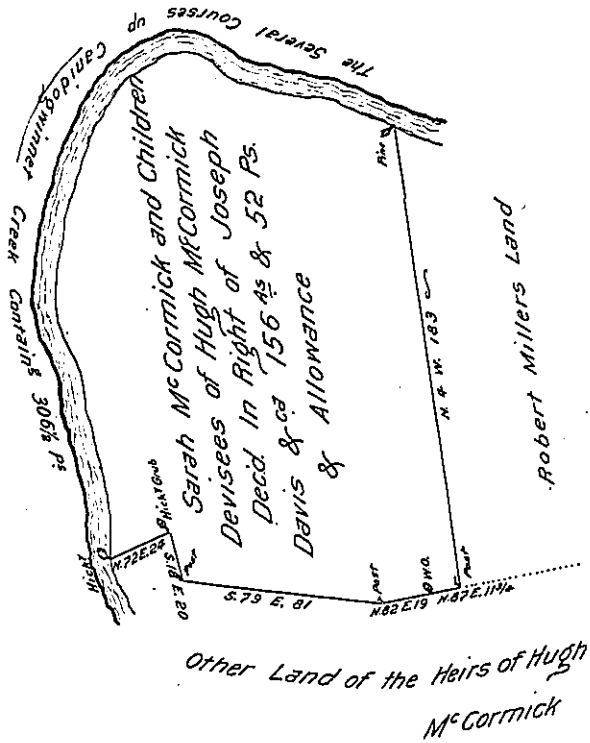


The following is a copy of a lease slip enclosed within this draft

Cent. for Roads &c Resurveyed and Divided the 14th Day of November 1785 To Sarah M^cCormick and Children Devisees of Hugh M^cCormick Deceased in Right of the Heirs or Assignees of Joseph Davis Deceased being One Moiety or half part of that tract of Land for which the said Joseph Davis Obtained a Warrant from the Honourable the Proprietaries bearing Date the 4th Day of March 1744
