



Situate in Broadtop township Bedford County Containing 87 acres 72 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Being composed of the following surveys viz: One containing 135 perches and allowance of 6 per cent &c. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant for 1 acre & 85 perches granted to John Griffith dated the 14th of Oct 1853. An other containing 16 acres 57 perches & allowance Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Griffith for 20 acres dated the 8th of January 1853: resurveyed in pursuance of an Order of resurvey granted to said John Griffith dated the 3rd of January 1855, another containing 7 acres 77 perches & allowance Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Griffith & Aaron W. Evans for 13 acres dated 24th of May 1853: An other containing 34 acres 129 perches and allowance, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Figard for 25 acres dated 2nd of March 1829, and resurveyed on an Order of resurvey; And part of a tract containing 28 acres 12 perches and allowance being part of a tract that originally contained 374 acres & allowance Surveyed on warrant granted in the name of Miers Fisher for 400 acres dated 10th of April 1794, The above was surveyed, calculated & connected by Sam^l Ketterman in 1853 & 1854.
