



The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim Township (now) Franklin County & Contains three hundred and eighty three Acres and three quarters & allowance of Six & Cent & Co. (which together with 53 Acres 63 & all. Disputed by Henry Snively) was resurveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> June 1796 to the Heirs of Samuel Smith on a Warrant granted to John Scott bearing date August 13<sup>th</sup> 1746 - in pursuance of Directions from the Surveyor General on an Order of the Board of Property granted at the request of the Memorial of <sup>James</sup> Crawford Dated first April 1796.
