



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Upper Oxford and County of Chester, containing one hundred and sixty acres, eighty two and six tenth perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads, etc. Surveyed for John A. Reburn by W. H. Hogg the 29th day of November 1897, it being parts of two larger tracts containing three hundred and twenty one acres, — perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Maxwell dated the second day of October 1745, and of an application N^o. 350 entered by David Hayes the fifth day of August 1765.
