N.B. on the South East end or near thereof there has or is yet a good improvement thereon the above survey) (it appears to me & from the moast correct infirmation I yet have got the Improvemen has bin made for 25 or 30 years upon the Intention of the above Warrant therefore I have Surveyed as above — it appear there have bin wonce a Bonified Improvement on the Same for sum numbers of Years.) there has bin a house thereon & several Fruit trees whis appears to me to be planted for 15 or 16 years) (the Hous is all Decayed and is Abanded, but the Cleared land is under good Cultivation at this time — Likewise the above Survey or part on the West End thereof is claimed by Casper Heckert by a Smaul Improvment I suppose 2 or 3 Acres cleared) which have bin cleared 6 or 7 years or longer, and is under good cultivation) & a hous or cabbin I suppose ~~8~~ 8 by 10 feet with a streight ruff made with boards likewis a yong woman abit of a bed apot & afiewe other articles therein when I made the survey — but it did not appear as though they had bin there but a short time.
