



Situate between Piney & Clover Creeks about a mile & a half from Chapmans Mill in Woodberry township in the County of Huntingdon first Surveyed the 8th day of October 1794 In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Caleb Newbold dated the 25th day of August 1794 then said to contain four hundred fifty nine acres 8^{ps} & the usual allowance Resurveyed the 9th day of May 1826 In pursuance of an Order of Resurvey Granted by the Board of Property to John Patton dated the 1st day of March 1826 and now Contains Four hundred & Eleven acres 61^{ps} perches and the usual allowance.
