



Whereas in pursuance of a Warrant from the former Comm^{rs} of Property dated the 7th of 9ber 1684 there was soon after Survey^d unto Samuel Lewis of Chester County a Tract of Land Sit. in y^e part of the s^d Co^s since called y^e Townp. of Willis Town in right of the s^d S. Lewis's purchase of one moiety of 1000^{ac} originally granted to Jn^s Love the proportion of Liberty Land thereto appurt^d first deducted, w^{ch} s^d Tract being Resurveyed by Is. Taylor in pursuance of a Gen^l Warr^t from the late Comm^{rs} of Property for Resur^v the Co^s afores^d was found to be limited & bound^d as follows Vizt. Sit. in the Townp. of Willis Town Begin^g at a red oak at a Corn^r of the Lands of Tho^s Barker & Company, of Tho. Massey & Francis Yarnal & extend^d thence by s^d Yarnal's Land S. 66 W. 157 per. to a W.O. thence by William Garret's Land N. 24 W. 680 per. thence by a line of marked Trees N. 66 E. 157 per. to a corner of the Land of s^d Barker & Compa^y; thence by the same S. 24 E. 680 to the begin^g contain^g 492^{ac} & allow. of 10% Cent as usual on Resurveys & an Overplus of 119^{ac} & Allow. of 6% Cent.

Returned into the Secret^{ry}'s Office the 19th of 9ber A. D. 1737.
 The said Samuel Lewis about the year 1724 having granted 300^{ac} of the above Tract to his daught^r Eliz^a & 200^{ac} to his daughter Mary Pennock wife of Jos. Pennock the tract was proportionally divided, & the s^d Mary's part being $\frac{2}{3}$ of his whole right was separately Returnd & c. the day afores^d. In Pursuance of a Warr^t from the proprietary dated the same day.
