Since Divided &c. Now on the 17th day of April A.D. 1839, Resurveyed the above &c. by the old Settled lines of the present adjoiners, and in the presence of all the adjoiners, For and at the request of the present owner, John Hass, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation.
